South Seminole is a Leadership and Global Connections Magnet School. The focus of the magnet program is designed to spark the student's initiative and leadership potential in a global society. The curriculum develops the skills students need to become productive and responsible leaders of the future. Students have the opportunity to explore the language and culture of societies that impact our daily lives. Current technology is utilized to connect with other schools throughout the world to investigate global issues.



The magnet program provides:

- Integration of Sean Covey's The 7 Habits of High Effective Teens
- Focus on self leadership, school leadership, and community leadership
- Leadership, global health and anthropology electives
- Cultural studies that include exposure to multiple languages through Rosetta Stone
- Opportunities to participate in JROTC, Dance and exploration of the arts
- Opportunity to earn high school credits in Algebra, Geometry, and Spanish I

South Seminole also offers preparation for the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Program. The Seminole County Public Schools Pre-IB Preparatory Program \* offers an extensive course of study in math, science, foreign language, social studies and language arts--with an emphasis on independent study, in-depth learning and accelerated curriculum requirements. Eighth grade students who complete the SCPS Pre-IB Preparatory Program at South Seminole Middle School and submit an application during the application period for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program are guaranteed admission.
