What Makes Us Special

- Implementation of Franklin Covey's LEAD program and The 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens empowers students to find their voice, chart their course, and prepare for success in high school and beyond.
- Advanced Studies include the Seminole County Public Schools Pre-IB Prep Program, world language immersion, legal studies, gifted instruction, and high school credit opportunities.
- We offer over 35 Leadership Academies where students have voice and choice in which talents they choose to explore. Each academy has a Pay It Forward project to provide service to the community.

South Seminole Academy offers the following high school courses for high school credit: Spanish 1, Spanish 1 IB, Algebra 1 Honors, Geometry Honors, Environmental Science Honors

Technology and the Future

All middle school students are provided opportunities to earn either a digital tool or industry certification through the completion of the following courses:





- iChallenge: This coding and game-based course prepares students to take AP Computer Science Principles in high school. (Semester or year-long options vary by school)
- iConnect: Students discover new possibilities and learn about technology applications and communication techniques.

Student Achievement 2021-2022 Data

- All students in 8th grade at South Seminole Academy Middle School have an opportunity to take the PSAT 8/9 at no cost.
- Last year, South Seminole Academy 8th graders had an average score of 816 out of 1440, higher than the Florida average of 810.

South Seminole Middle School earned a B grade from the Florida DOE in 2022.


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- Magnet Schools of America recognized South Seminole Academy as a National Certified Magnet School.
